### **Invitation for Tenders**

1. This Invitation for Tenders follows the General Procurement Notice for this Project which appeared in **PPRA Journal** Issue no. **1821-6021 Vol X-No.31** dated **1<sup>st</sup> August, 2017**.
2. The Dar es Salaam City Council is looking for the Firm/Firms to operate and collect parking fees and charging wrong parking fines/penalties on behalf of Dar es salaam City Council as follows:
  - Ilala Zone (Lot 1) with **8,474** parking slots
  - Kinondoni and Ubungo Zone (Lot 2) with **3,300** parking slots
  - Temeke and Kigamboni Zone (Lot 3) with **870** parking slots
3. The Dar es Salaam City Council now invites sealed tenders from any reputable firm which can use the best efficient, effective and economic methods for the Management and Operations, Collections of Revenue from on –street car parking and charging wrong parking fines/penalties in Dar es Salaam. Bidders are free to bid in either all or any lot of interest.
4. Tendering will be conducted through the National Competitive Tendering procedures specified in the Procurement Act No. 7 of 2011 and the Public Procurement Regulations of 2013 – Government Notice No. 446. The tenders are open to all eligible National Tenderers as defined in the Regulations unless otherwise stated in the **Tender Data Sheet**.

5. Interested eligible Tenderers may obtain further information from and inspect the Tendering Documents at the office of the **Tender Board Secretary, Dar es Salaam City Council P.O. Box 9084 Dar es Salaam. Ground floor PMU's Office** from 9.00am to 3.00pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive except on public holidays.

A complete set of Tendering Documents in **English** may be purchased from the Dar es Salaam City Council by interested Tenderers upon payment of non-refundable fee of Tanzania Shilling. **200,000.00** Payment should be deposit on Bank **Account Na. 0150211141600 CRDB PLC**, payable to the Dar es Salaam City Council.
7. All Tenders must be accompanied by a Tender Securing Declaration in the format provided in the Tendering Documents.
8. All tenderers are encouraged to visit the sites before tendering at their own arrangement cost
9. All tenders in one original plus two (2) copies, properly filled in, and enclosed in plain envelopes must be delivered to the address **of the Tender Board Secretary, P.O. Box 9084 Dar es Salaam. Ground floor PMU's Office** at or before **02:00 hour's local time on 12<sup>nd</sup> October, 2017**. Tenders will be opened promptly thereafter in public and in the presence of Tenderers' representatives who will choose to attend the opening ceremony which will be held **at the Board Room, 2<sup>nd</sup> floor - City Hall at the junction of Morogoro Road/Sokoine Drive**.
10. Late tenders, portion of tenders, electronic tenders, and tenders not received, tenders not opened and not read out in public at the tender opening ceremony shall not be accepted for evaluation irrespective of the circumstance.
